Creative Classrooms

Crafted to create classrooms that are bursting with imagination

Drama can be embedded into all aspects of the KS1 & 2 curriculum. It can be a useful tool into topic work, a practical way of teaching core subjects and a method of nurturing oracy. Theatre techniques are also invaluable for classroom management, creating routine and teaching life skills.

During this CPD your teachers will gain skills and confidence to embed and use drama techniques effectively in the classroom throughout each term.



Vocal Vitality

Crafted to support versatile and healthy voices in teachers

Loosing your voice is common concern for teachers, especially towards the end of term. This can be caused by many factors including stress, lack of information about the voice and environmental factors.

Actors train for several years to learn how to warm up and use their voice. These techniques can be used to help teachers look after their voice and use it more effectively to help conserve it right through to the end of term.



Supporting Storytelling

Crafted to help teachers support their families in sharing stories

Listening to and reading stories is an essential part of a child's development. This session will help teachers to support young people's storytelling skills both in the classroom and at home.

Working with a storyteller from The Watermill, you will explore techniques to help develop imaginative, listening and storytelling skills that can be shared and enjoyed with all the family.

Thanks to funding from Greenham Trust, we can also offer an subsidised and adapted version of this session as an after-school opportunity for young people and their parents or carers.

Timings & Costings

Training days can be scheduled to suit your school timetable. Our CPD is individually priced based on number of teachers, length of the day and training objectives.

- Half day (3-hours): £45 per teacher with a minimum fee of £450+travel
- 90-minute after-school session: £15 per teacher, with a minimum fee of £225+travel
