We deliver workshops on most aspects of theatre and drama. Below is a selection of what we do, but please call if you have your own ideas.

ELIZABETHAN or JACOBEAN DRAMA

Focusing on your choice of play. Recent workshops include *Othello*, *Romeo and Juliet*, *The Revenger's Tragedy* and *The Duchess of Malfi*.

DRAMA FOR ENGLISH

Looking at any of your set playtexts for English GCSE, AS or A2 from an actor's point of view.

THEATRE PRACTITIONERS

We have actors and directors who can share their experience of the methods of most well-known practitioners, such as Shared Experience, Complicité, Brecht, Stanislavski, Katie Mitchell, and Actors of Dionysus.

PERFORMANCE SKILLS

We can focus on a particular aspect of performing such as acting, singing, stage combat, monologues, or preparation for drama school auditions.

Our standard workshops last for 90 minutes and cost from £160 plus travel (for up to 30 students).
